# DOOR POLICY

- Members and guests will be admitted to the Members' areas during normal hours of admission.
- Upon arrival to Neera, Members can present their digital members card , or provide their name to the hostess, in order to search the membership directory and confirm identity.
- The hostesses will be required to review the membership profile and picture; if the individual does not match the profile, or is unable to supply any of the membership ID's or correct membership information to identify themselves, they will be denied entry.
- If a member arrives with guests, all guest names and phone numbers must be registered by the hostess upon entry on the members profile.
- Members will be allowed to take up to four guests at any time, larger groups will require an advance dining reservation.
- No person under the age of 21 will be admitted to the Neera without the prior written permission from management, except during specific time periods/events as defined by Management.
- Guests will not be able to enter or remain on the premises in the absence of the hosting Member. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests and must ensure guests abide by the Rules and the Privacy Policy.
- With advance written notice, Neera reserves the right to parts of, or all of Neera for public holidays and private events.
- The Management may refuse admission to the Neera if they fail to abide by our Dress Code policy and/or Members Codes of Conduct. Management reserves the right to temporarily suspend club access based on violations of membership Codes of Conduct. Management may also terminate or choose not to renew membership subject to behaviours and committee review.





# DRESS CODE POLICY

Neera operates a strict smart-elegant dress code policy, which all members and guests must adhere to.

The following dress will not be permitted at Neera:

- Sports caps
- Shorts
- Overly tight T-shirts
- T-shirts with large brand logos, prints, slogans, or graphic images
- Sportswear, hooded jumpers, tracksuits or singlets
- Sports shoes or open footwear
- Ripped or distressed jeans
- Overly revealing attire

Local dress is most welcome, but kandoras will not be permitted in the Peacock Lounge.

Those who do not follow the dress-code policy may be refused entry. The decision is entirely at the discretion of the reception team. We ask that you ensure the dress code is conveyed to any guests you invite to the club.
